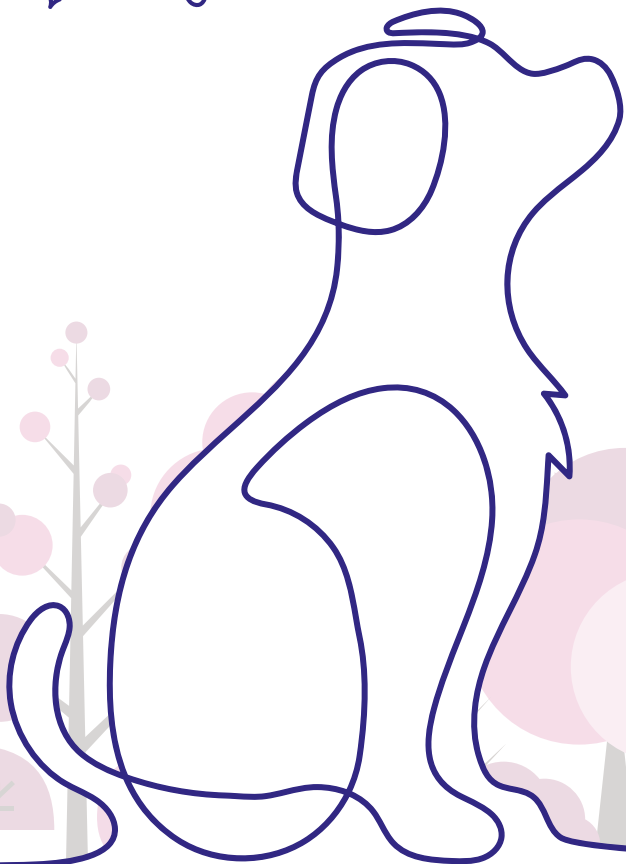
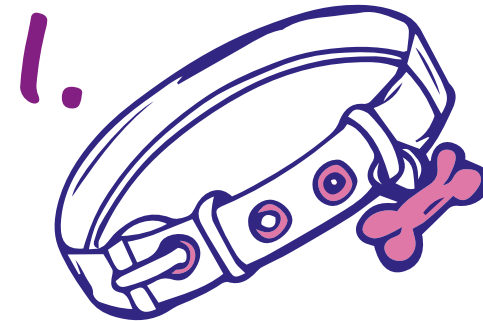


How to treat bee and wasp stings

1. **Restrain your pet**

2. **Remove the stinger**
(if a bee sting)

TIP: Use a credit card to scrape out a bee stinger avoid tweezers or nails, as they can squeeze more venom; wasps don't leave stingers behind.



3. **Soothe the sore area**

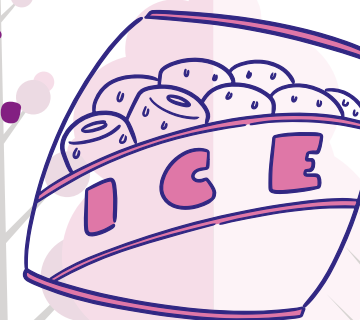


4. **Acidic (B*)**
– Wasp

Alkaline (A*)
– Bee

Neutralise the sting

5. **Apply ice**



6. **Don't give medication**

(A*) Bee Sting: Bicarbonate of soda **(B*) Wasp Sting:** Vinegar
