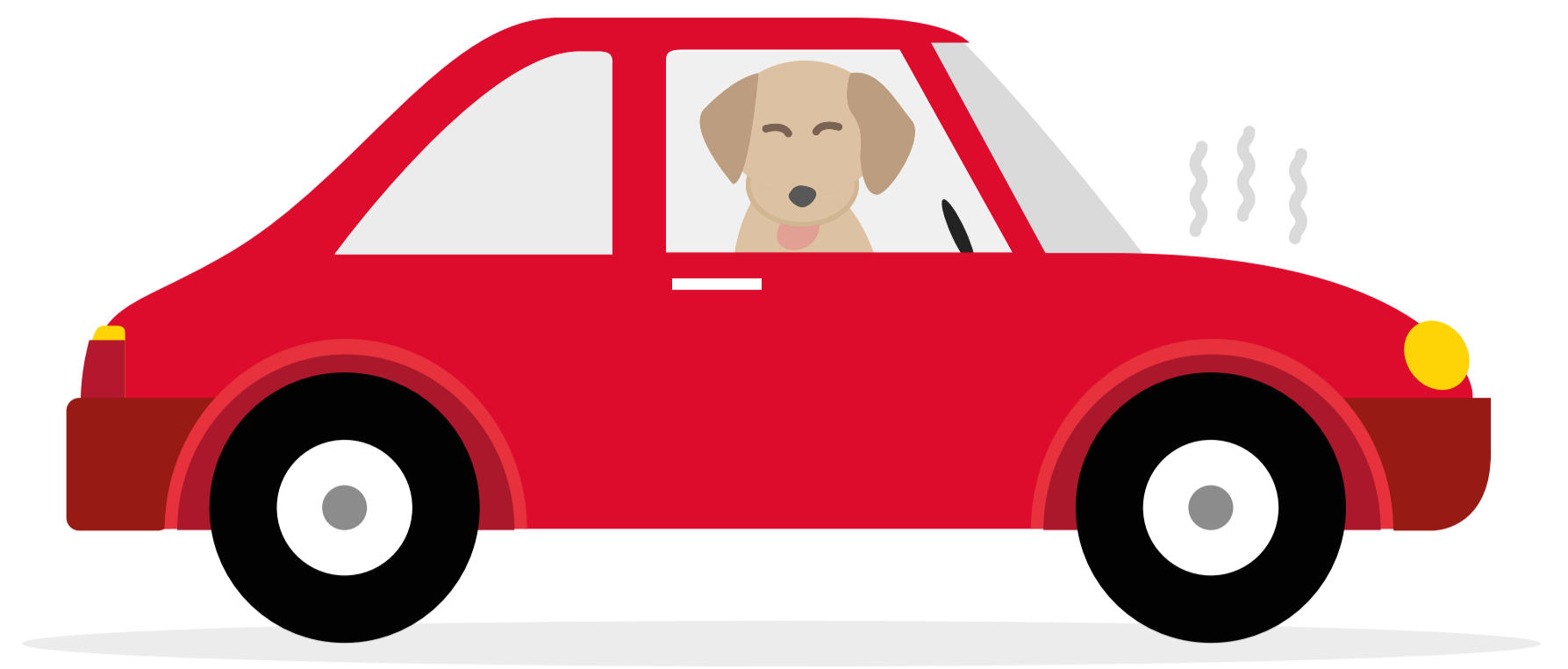


# Never Ever Leave Your Dog in a Hot Car



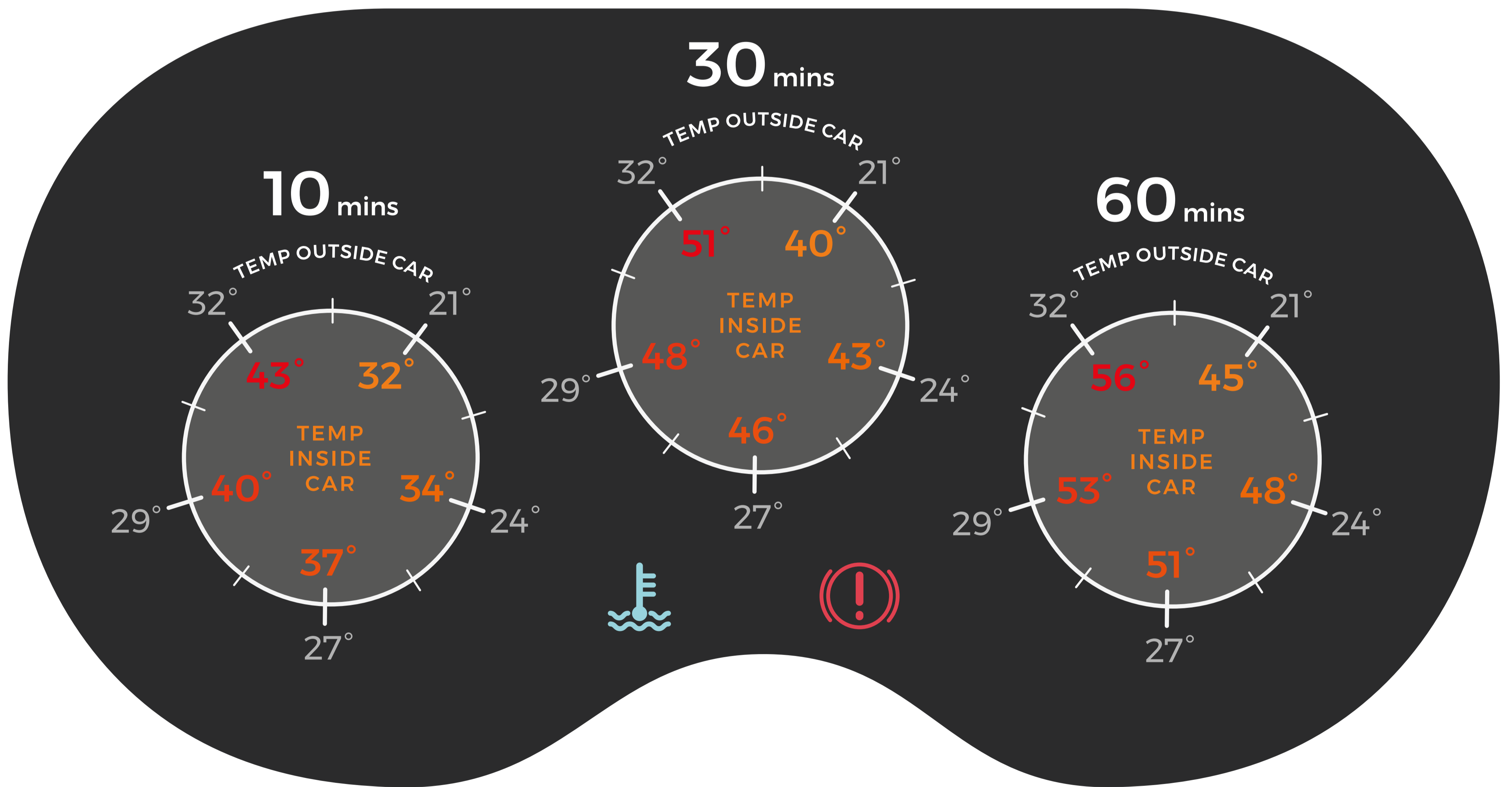
Just a 2°C increase in a dog's body temperature is all it takes for heat stroke to kick in. Fatalities can occur in as little as 15 minutes.
